Please note that there will be no provision to load presentations on-the-spot or during speaker transition. All presentations will be pre-loaded on session laptops and ready to go when you arrive.
- 4) Each session room has a LCD projector, laptop computer, sound system, podium and cordless microphones, and screen. If you have any special audio-visual needs, please let us know right away.
- 5) Please note that the session laptop computer will NOT have internet connectivity.
- 6) The conference planning committee will be meeting over breakfast on Wednesday, May 12 to discuss post-conference publication plans. After the conference, you will receive an e-mail with instructions on how to submit a revised version of your paper. In addition to revised versions of papers, all Powerpoint presentations (in PDF format) will be made available at the conference website. The papers and presentations will be accessible only by creating an account with the website and logging in as a user. We do not anticipate publishing hard copy proceedings from this conference.
